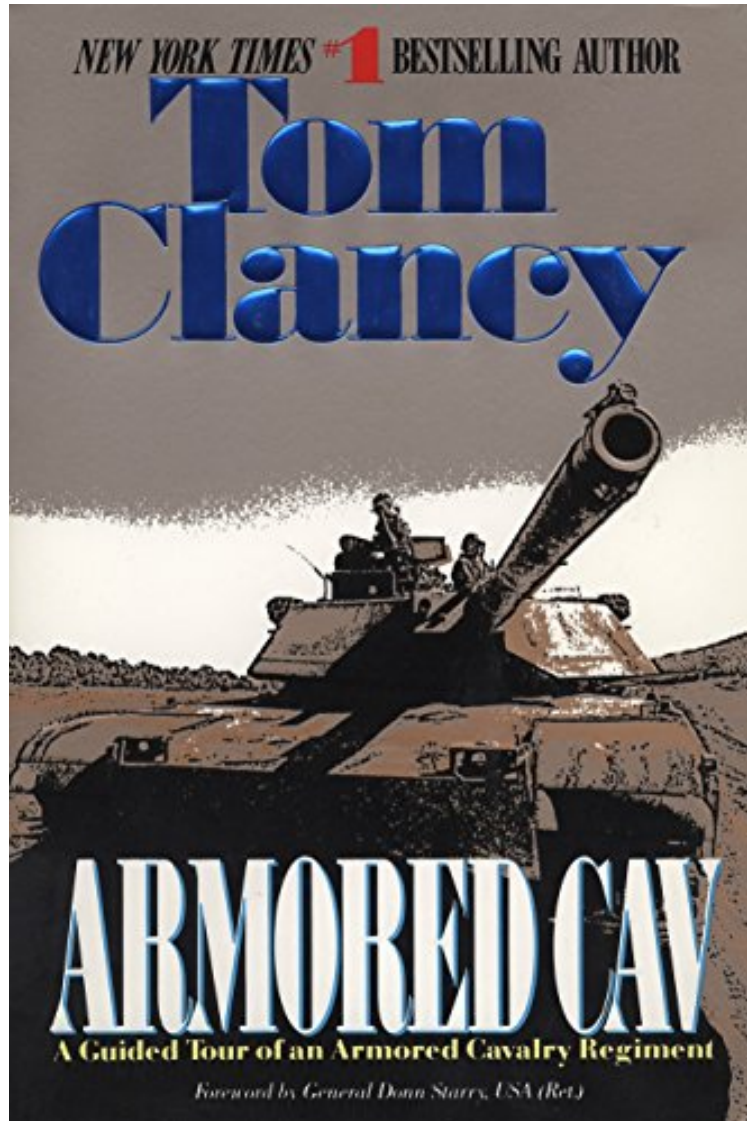

A persuasive argument for a strong Armored Cavalry.Von dwdavison@aol.comIf the folks in Washington who set the defense budget and determine how much money is to be allocated for army ordnance and materiel were to read this book, I think it would help clarify for them why exactly we need to maintain a strong armored cavalry to support our U.S. ground forces. We have grown too complacent if we believe that all security threats can be resolved by simply launching missiles from the sea or dropping bombs from the air, hoping to cow the enemy into submission by sustained and heavy bombardment. There comes a time when the surgical excision of a belligerent element or hostile force is more necessary and, in the long run, more effective and beneficial, both economically and politically. But such action requires a powerful wall of mobile armor to ensure that the men and women participating in any such operation are defended by the best MBT's and IFV's that money can buy. Tom Clancy describes in magnificent detail some of these vehicles, and gives examples of the hardware in action against Soviet-made tanks during Operation Desert Storm. The book also includes informative interviews with some of the outstanding individuals who've helped raise the army to the standard it is today, and who hope to keep those forces strong through the next millenium. Good introduction to armored cavalryVon Ein KundeFor me, this book was a fine introduction to what makes up today's armored cav--the armored vehicles, the weapons, the personnel, the training and the missions. I was especially impressed by his discussion of how GPS works. However, I felt that Clancy was weak on the history of the development of armored cav. I would have liked to have seen more discussion of how armored cav evolved from say, World War I through World War II, Korea, Vietnam right up to today. Clancy did a wonderful job of discussing the development of the submarine in his first nonfiction work SUBMARINE, and he would again talk about the history of the Marine Corps in his book about the Marines. Similarly, he should have talked about the history of the development of armored cavalry--Clancy's already proven that it's quite fascinating. Also, as with his other nonfiction works (save for INTO THE STORM) this book could use an index. For example, I saw a reference to the Sherman Tank in the glossary in the back; however, I could not find any references to it in the book itself. With his novels, and with nonfiction works such as this one, Clancy has probably done more to introduce the public to today's military than anyone else. I hope he continues to write nonfiction books such as this one, and I plan to continue buying them.
