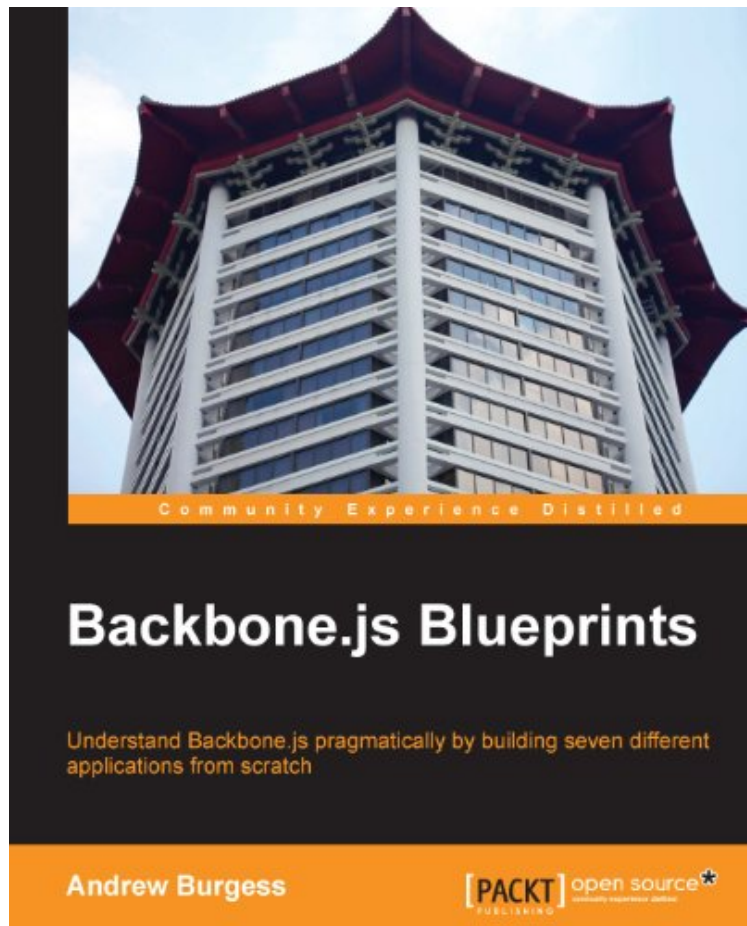

Nevertheless, it's important to know the backend stuff for games and there are plenty of books and frameworks for html5 canvas if you feel like it.I recommend to get some knowledge about node.js before reading this book. That is REALLY important, because the blueprints are based on node.js as a server and some very famous modules like express.js, passport.js and grunt.js. Those are not really the easiest modules in node.js, but i do like that the author uses node.js instead of PHP. Being a big node.js fan and stuff
