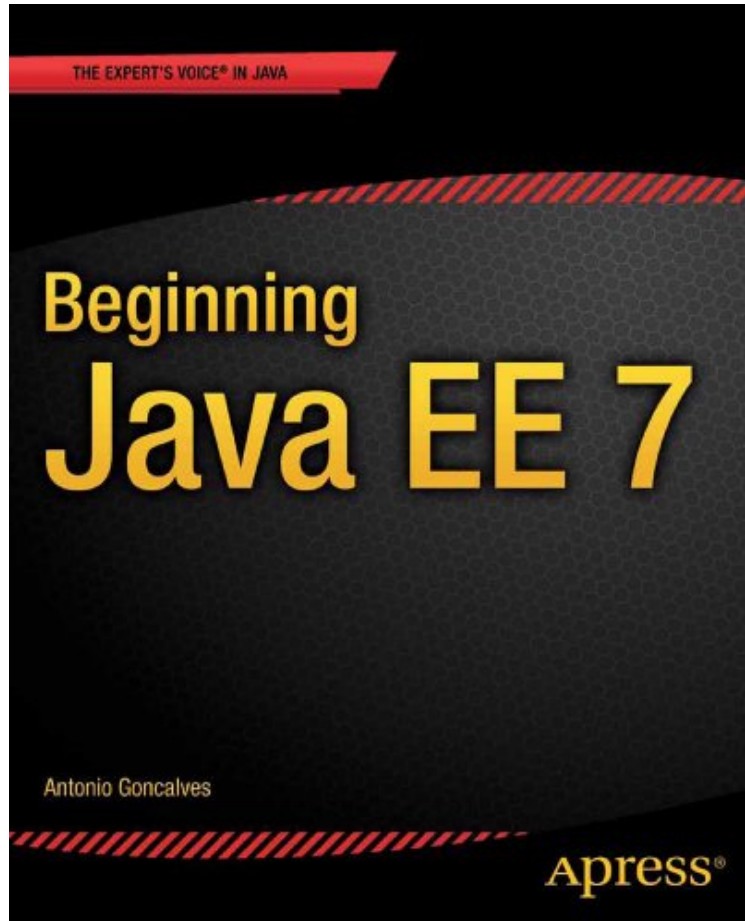

Modern Java frameworks use a lot of voodoo, which (A) i find unsatisfying and (B) relatively few practitioners can really explain (meaning that when things break, few know how to fix it). This book takes a step back from such frameworks, demonstrating the core language features that such frameworks are based on and, in doing so, demystifies much of the voodoo witnessed in modern enterprise applications. The conversation with the reader stays simple while still providing a useful level of detail - i do not get the feeling that the author is either dumbing down too much nor speaking to his reader from atop some high-horse.
