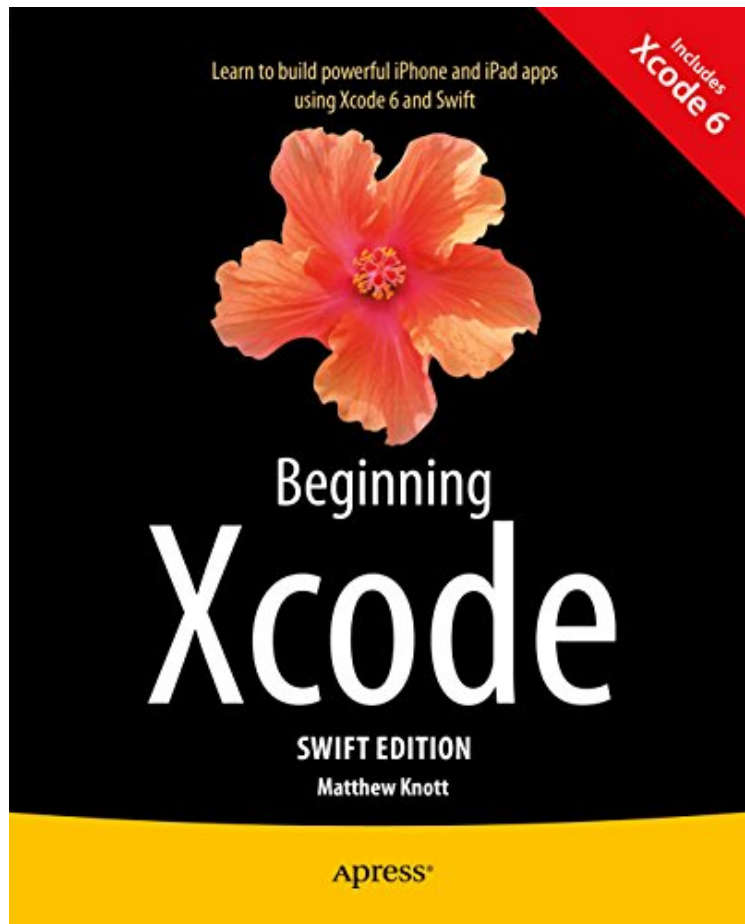

What is helpful to learn the code completion support of Xcode. But it is not that much necessary to write that much. The author mentions some code you can download to use. There are 15 chapters, and you get code to download for about three.Not enough if you consider to learn Xcode and not coding in swift.The author explains and mentions so often (for me too much) how the reader will create in future soon so much amazing apps. You get almost the feeling, you only need to read this book to create amazing

apps. Surprise: You, the Inventor, still needs to have some good ideas for your own! Without you only create amazing solution to exercises. Pictures are good and well chosen. It is always clear on what you have to focus. But there are some minor flaws in some pictures. Call me an Apple-worshiper. But some pictures shows context to Android Apps. This book is for Apples Xcode, why not stick to it. One final minor point, the social app example needs in any way a Twitter account. This, is not really necessary. The author could have given a work around code example with and without Twitter account. Cause the whole chapter is about Xcode functions and not Twitter. For beginners with no experience and the strict deny of Twitter is the hint of the author to create and delete an account on Twitter not acceptable.
