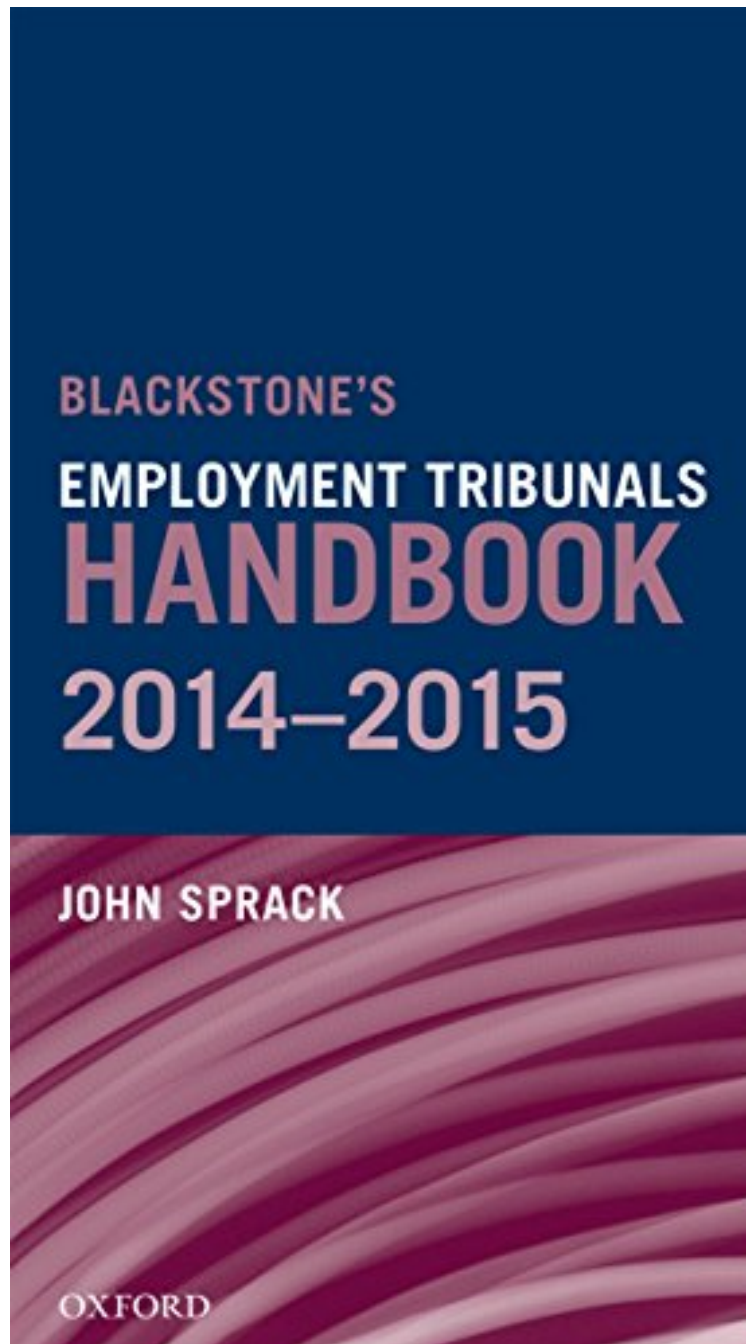

Small but exceptionally illuminating for practitioners and lay persons alike and scarcely bigger than the average tablet phone, this little Handbook is somewhat surprising really, considering the range of material inside concerning the law and practice of employment tribunals. The Handbook, says author John Sprack, is aimed at anyone involved in cases in employment tribunals, whether practitioners, or litigants presenting their own case or those advising either employers, or employees, whether legally qualified or not. The Handbook is useful, therefore, for HR professionals or advisers at Citizens Advice Bureaus, or inevitably trade union representatives or officials. Noteworthy for its clarity and conciseness, this is a legal text that favours clear explanations and a refreshing lack of legalese. Its plain English approach will render it immediately understandable and accessible to almost all readers -- especially with its frequent use of flowcharts, tables and boxed shaded sections designed to enhance understanding and ease of use. Its compact size means of course that the focus is on key aspects and common issues of employment tribunal practice that emerge within situations that most frequently occur in tribunals. Those seeking further advice, or further detail will appreciate a particularly useful feature of the Handbook, namely that it contains numerous cross references throughout to Blackstones Employment Law Practice the leading work of reference in this field, which was published shortly after the Handbook. This little-and-large, so to speak, duo of Employment Tribunals Handbook 2014-2015 and Employment Law Practice together make a wise purchase for the employment lawyer and certainly for any practitioner specializing in tribunals. Author John Sprack -- whose impressive list of credentials includes eleven years of teaching Employment Law at the Inns of Court School of Law (now City Law School) and serving as an employment judge for fifteen years -- has created an authoritative, as well as concise work of reference, which is also a rather fascinating read.
