Wapner is a decent humorous piece of self-published literature, a novel that will entertain reader and many times make you laugh with its satiric story. Starting from the first page, the author introduces reader to the story of the alternate reality picturing the world in which the agencies that protect the copyrights (movies and music mainly) completely defeated the opposition - but the outcome and the world that was consequently created is somewhere on the border of the bizarre. In the same manner the author leads you through the whole story, making hard for reader to stop laughing, while in same time we are questioning ourselves how far from the reality the portrayed events could be in some alternate universe. John Wapner with his debut managed to write a book that will keep you entertained through all of its 500 pages while travelling with Mack Gehapo, an agent for the Guild of the American Recording Syndicate that has almost unlimited powers in prevention of music being stolen from their makers. And though it may seem this book is too thick, the author succeeded in his satirical story not to repeat himself, again and again making reader laugh though actually discussing quite serious topic of human freedom and rights. Therefore, though can be observed this is a work of self-published author, John Wapner manages to tackle some taboos and somehow delivers much more challenging work than one can expect on its beginning - and because of that Music Cop can certainly be recommended.
