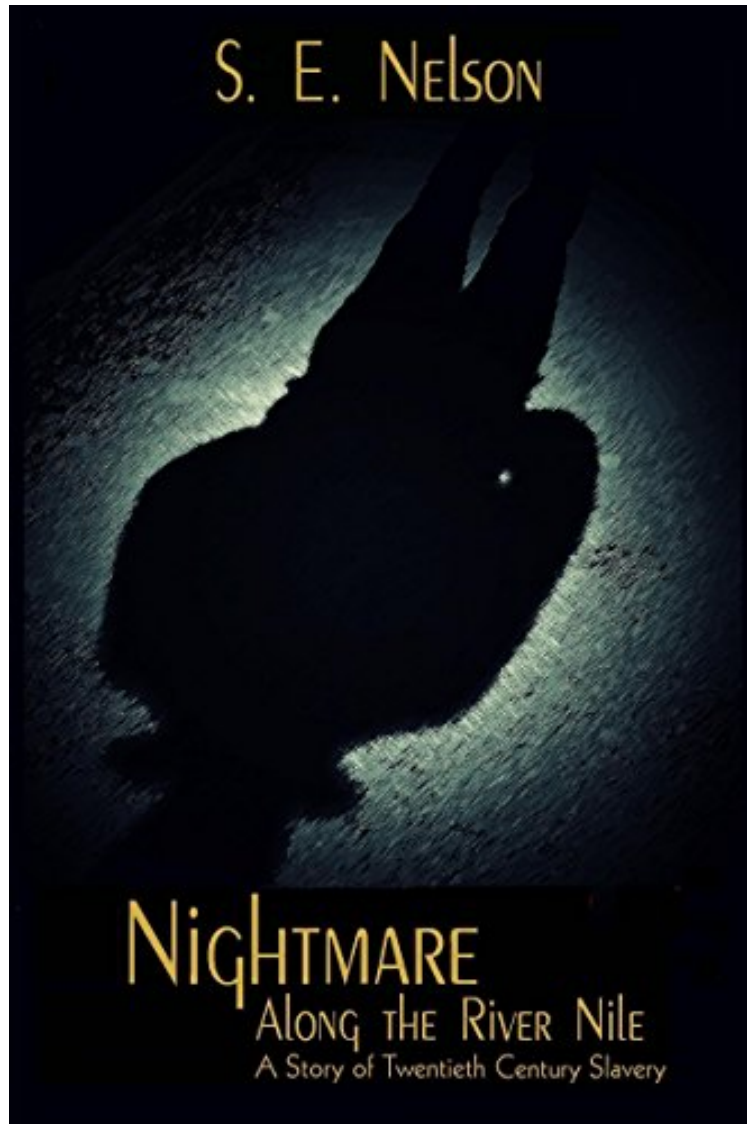

Die Umsetzung des Themas ist nicht ganz vollkommen gelungen. Auch wenn vorab gewarnt wurde, dass bewusst eine sehr einfache Form des Englischen benutzt wird, ist es doch manchmal noch zu einfach. Zum einen spricht der Hauptcharakter auch sonst viel Englisch, zum anderen hat er gerade seinen Highschool Abschluss hinter sich... und würde damit dann nicht in einem langen Absatz jeden Satz mit "ich" beginnen. Außerdem wird die zeitliche Abfolge insbesondere bei Eddie nicht immer klar. So bekommt man z.B. den Eindruck, dass ihnen die Achillessehnen durchgeschnitten werden und sie sofort am nächsten Tag weiter gehen müssen, was meines Erachtens nach ein Ding der Unmöglichkeit wäre. Fazit: Sehr wichtiges Thema, sollte man gelesen haben.
