Of course you can always this to be beyond the scope of a "Getting Started" Book, but in 15 years DWH projects I have not seen an environment where you can get by without this.Secondly the Kindle Edition: I like EBooks, I like the Kindle app and the flexibilty across a wide range of platforms. I have not purchased Hardcopies of Fiction for years. However it's different with non fiction particularly programming / development guides like this one. Working on WIndows Client Software, Kindle Software runs in App Mode, so I would need multiple Monitors to look at Book and OWB client side by side (possibly there are ways to install Kindle Software on Windows 8 as a windowed application, but I don't know how). In addition, Illustrations in the book cannot be zoomed (haven't found any stting to scale them - as a result on a 24" 4k Screen they are tiny).
