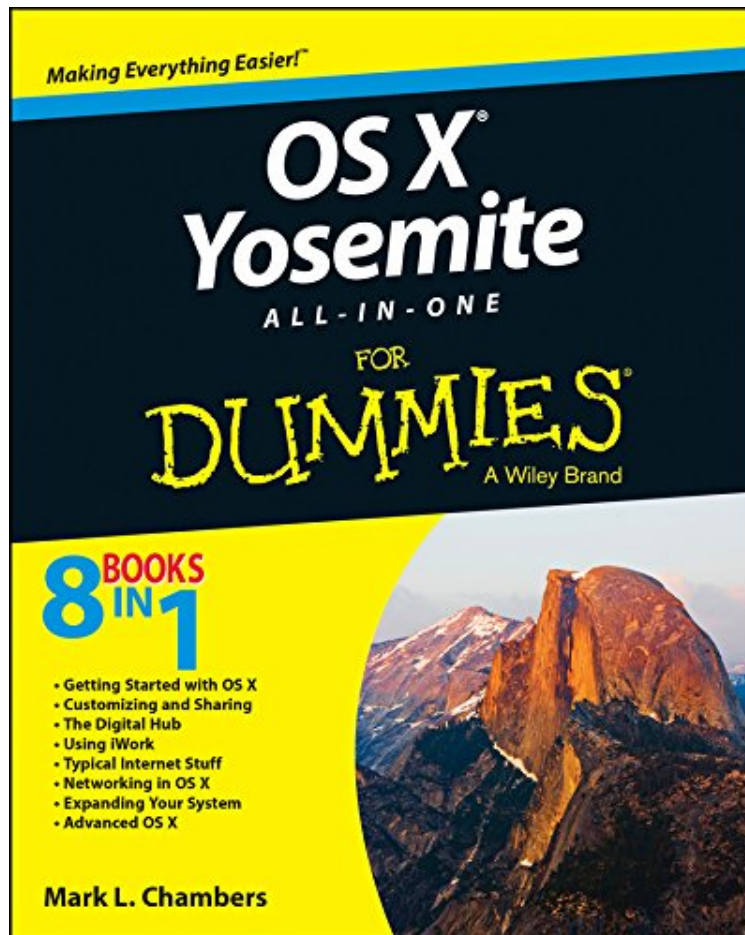

Die paar Seiten der kostenlosen Leseprobe waren ertrglich, aber - je nach Schriftgre - ber tausend Seiten lang: Dear reader, fear not, for without further ado I present to thee the mighty FINDER, able to perform the most amazing tasks...echt jetzt? - Die Applebeweihrucherung ist extrem penetrant. Ich arbeite mit Windows, Android und iOS und habe mich im Vorfeld mit Mac OS auseinandergesetzt und bewusst dafr entschieden. Jetzt in jedem Absatz mindestens einmal unter die Nase gerieben zu bekommen, wie toll "The Big X " ist, grenzt an Gehirnwsche. Hoffentlich hat der Autor dafr wenigstens ein paar schne Gadgets geschenkt bekommen.

Kabel prfen und Rechner neu starten beispielsweise. Ich hatte die Erwartung, inmitten all der Floskeln und Hinweise, wie toll Mac Os ist, weiterfhrende Informationen zum Betriebssystem und dem Arbeiten damit, insbesondere im Vergleich zu Windows, zu bekommen.
