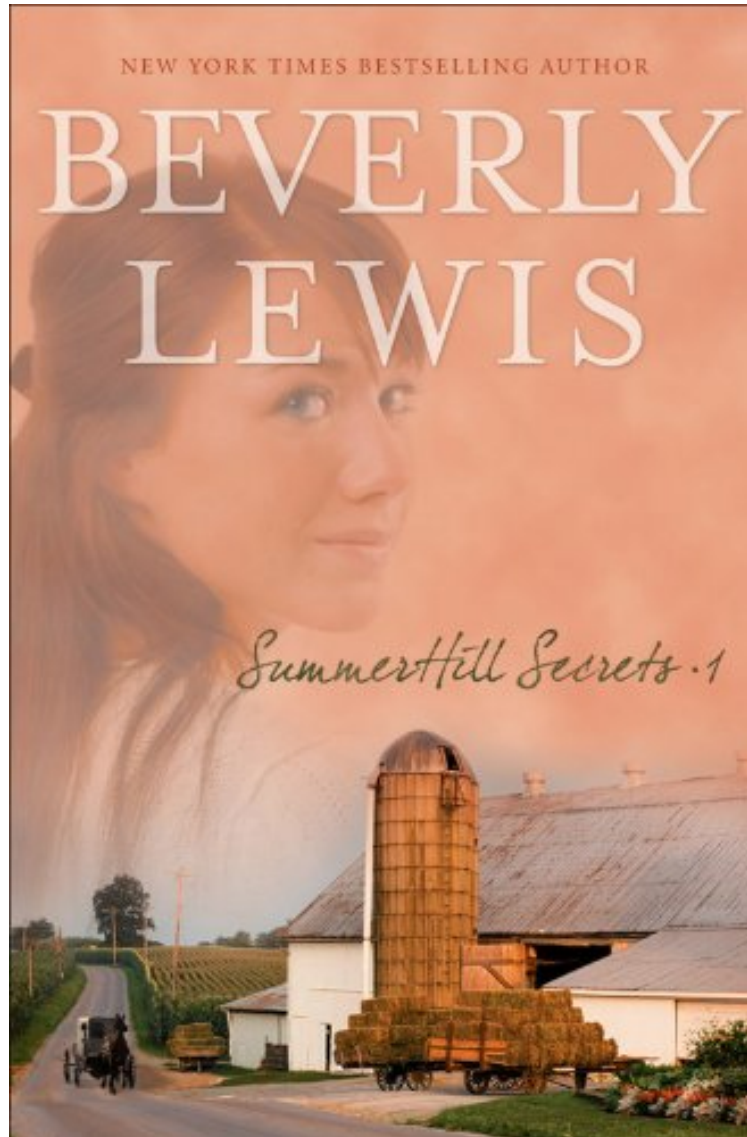

Tons of these are currently littering book-shops and their most distincitive feature is the recurrent use of Food and Clothing. The characters in these novels eat and clothe themselves in precisely measurable intervals. In a bad case the

reader knows exactly what the hero is wearing but not what he/she looks like. Summerhill Secrets is insofar remarkable since its plot isn't set in California or New York or Montana but in the Amish Society of Pennsylvania. Fifteen year old Merry lives with her family that is normal to an almost unbearable extent (mother excellent housewife, brother and sister constantly fighting, father overworked but gentle doctor, lively christian community) in close neighbourhood to Amish people and is best friends with her distant amish cousin Rachel. This setting allows the author to introduce the reader to the amish way of life in a leisurely and convincing style. I recommend the book mostly for this feature. Aside from that it mostly deals with the usual suspects: boys, family, growing up. The only real tragedy is the death of Merry's twin sister Faithie years ago, that comes up sometimes like a background reminder but obviously didn't keep Merry from growing up rather normal.
