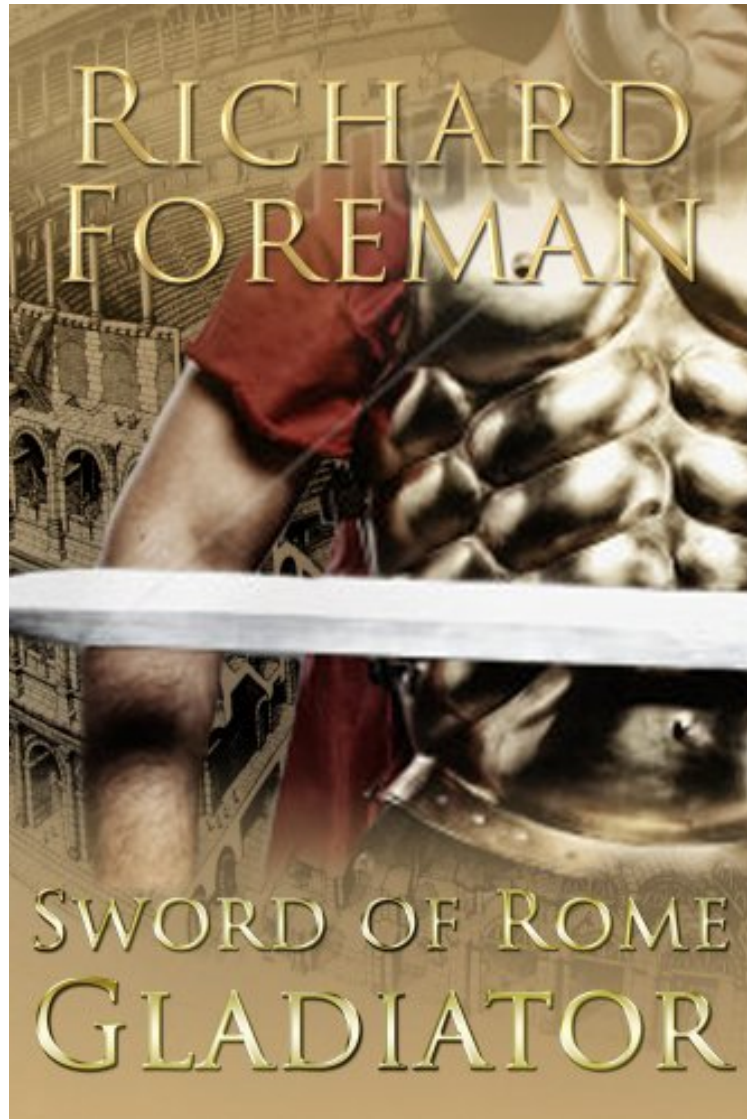

The powerful men were linked by Julia - Caesar's daughter and Pompey's wife - but since her death their relationship has fallen apart.Oppius, the skilled centurian from the previous novellas has been given a new mission by Caesar: to deliver

some important correspondence to the merchant Mallius, who possesses information on who can be trusted and who is rallying against the emperor. The greedy merchant will only give up the information on one condition: Oppius must pit his strength, and perhaps his life, against a vicious opponent in Mallius' gladiator school. Richard Foreman gives an evocative account of ancient Rome with his descriptions of lavish aromatic feasts, luxurious bath houses and blood-thirsty gladiatorial spectacles.
