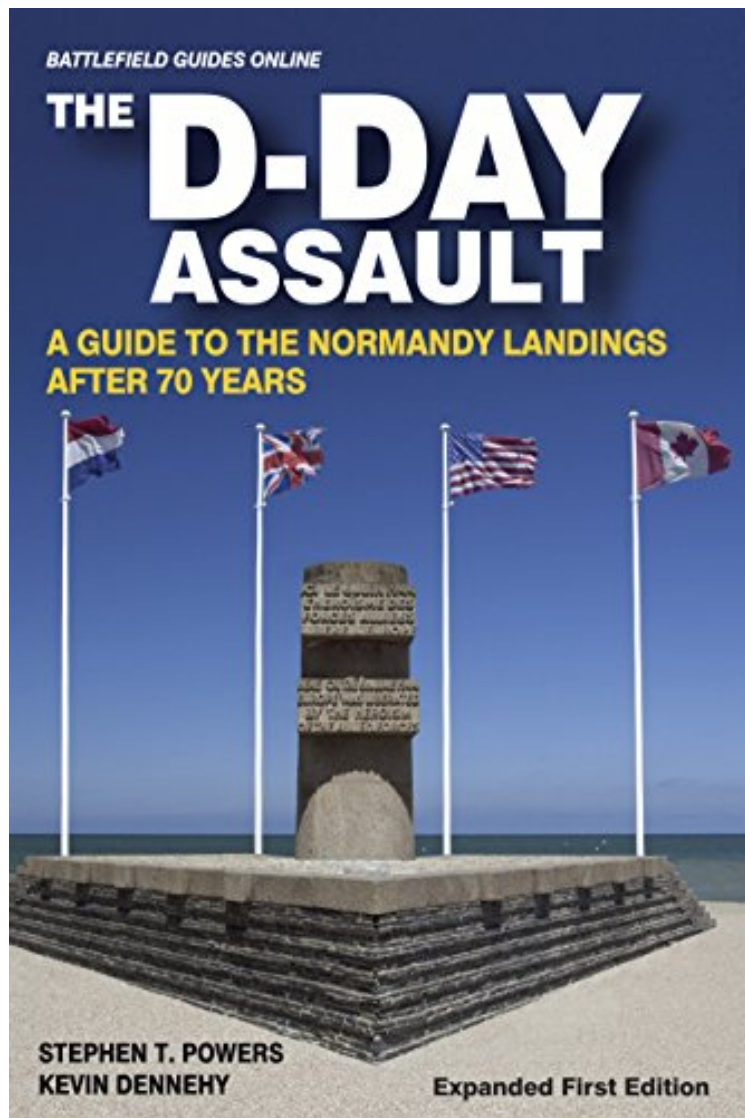

It helped a bit at places which I anyway wanted to visit, but was not that useful for travelling around.First remark, the book is written for Americans, having accomodation in Bayeux and have an own car to travel with.For everybody else, this book might have some useful informations about additional things to see (I would never have seen the special window in the church of St.Mre-Eglis without this book). But as a travel guide it has not that a big use.Second, the maps are fine for having a clue where what happend, but they are not that good for finding sightsAnd third, if you mentioned that for example Teddy Roosevelt Jr. and two other Medal of Honor's Holder are buried in Colleville Cemenetry; why not stating in which section and row. Also a thing that was missing and I think especially for Americans would have been interesting; the graves of the "real" brother "Ryan's" (they are called Niland) which inspired the movie "Saving Private Ryan".
