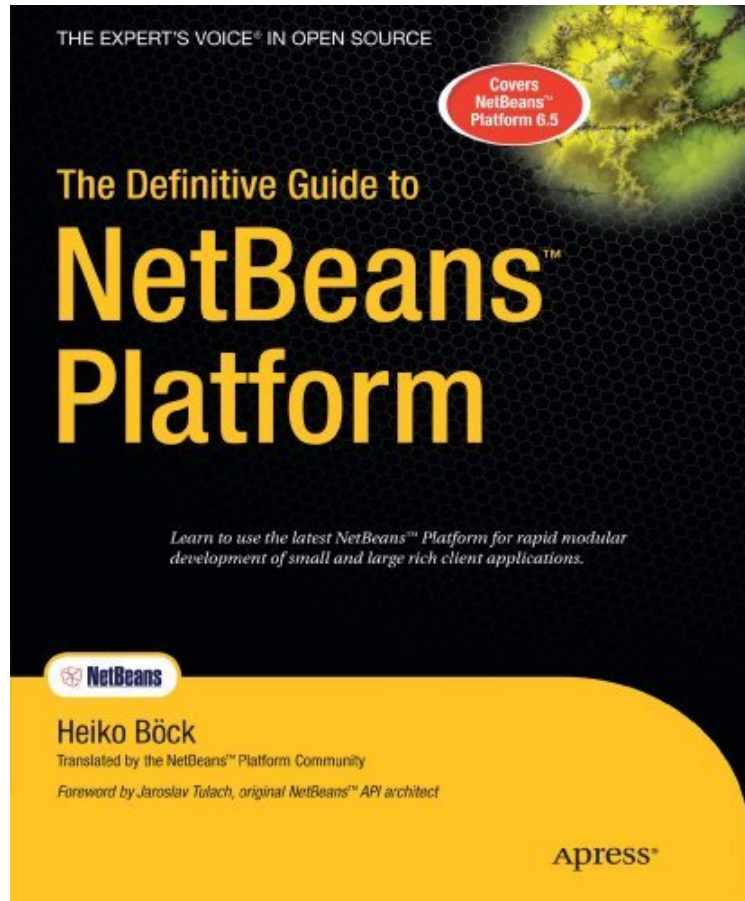

Introduction is given into an autonomous world with many configuration rules, a modular architecture, services, broad GUI support and many helpers, e.g., a specific file-data-node architecture which needs some familiarization. A world parallel to OSGi and Spring, e.g., but rather focussed on rich client GUIs in difference. Possibly a bit too much of configuration in comparison with classical Java programming. The logic of the book is a bit

queer because earlier chapters use notions from later ones without too good an explanation in the earlier stages. Moreover, at least in the English translation, the book is sometimes very hard to read: you understand quickly the example code but read thrice until understanding what is meant verbally. Information is partially very compressed. Reading the book needs time and one should not expect to get an overview in a quick manner. This is of course also due to the specific concepts of NetBeans. Die APIs, die man bentigt sind weitestgehend stabil, das Buch fehlerfrei und gut verstndlich geschrieben, wobei alle wichtigen Themen abgehandelt werden. Es gibt viele kleine Codebeispiele und einzig der Index hinten im Buch knnte etwas ausfhrlicher sein. Das finde ich aber auch nur, weil ich solche Bcher selten von hinten nach vorne durchlese, sondern meist hin- und her springe, je nach Problem, welches gerade angegangen wird.
