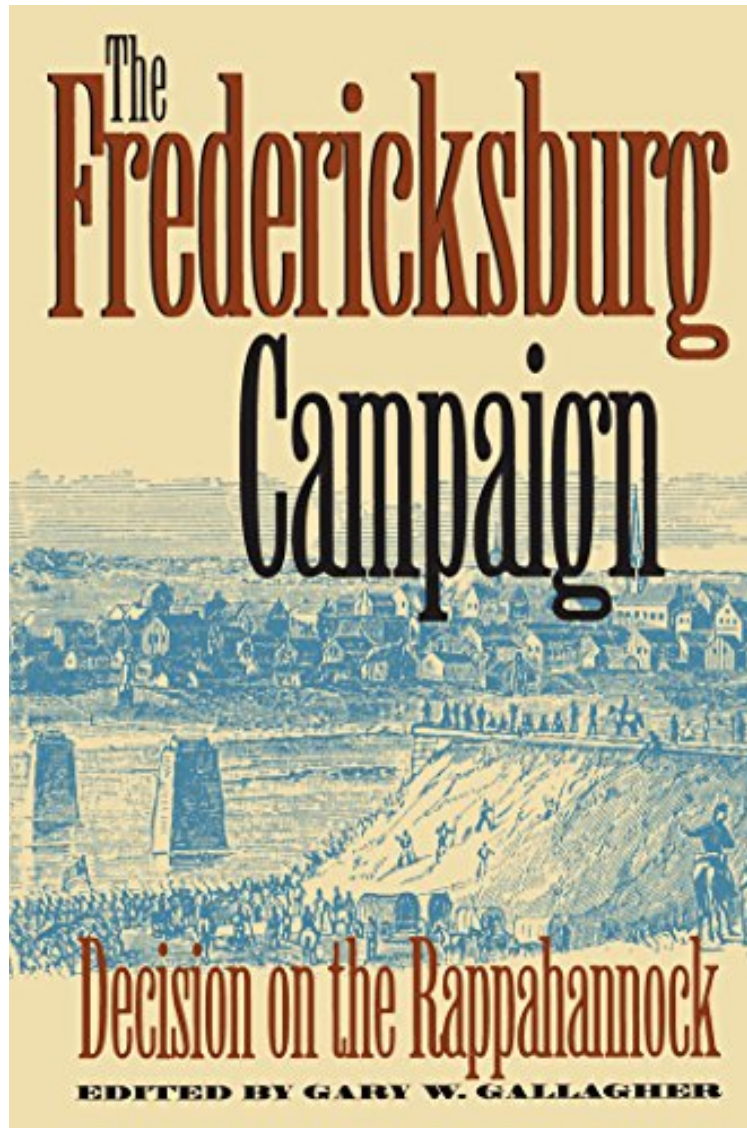


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## The Fredericksburg Campaign: Decision on the Rappahannock (Military Campaigns of the Civil War)
